Federal Legislation - CARES Act

- Allows access to defined contribution plans to employees impacted by COVID-19. Employee may take cash withdrawal from retirement savings account up to \$100,000 without paying a penalty, interest tax spread out over 3-year period. Employee must be impacted by virus.
- Employees can also borrow from retirement savings accounts. Employees may take up to 3 loans for a maximum of \$100,000. For a limited period.
- For retirees, required minimum distribution has been suspended for 2020.
