3. Approval of prior minutes – The January 2020 meeting minutes were approved after a few minor typographical edits.
4. Faculty Assembly Update - February 2020 meeting
 - a. EIT Accessibility Policy was approved by Faculty Assembly

 - a. Non-discrimination policy updates

 - ii. Tony Infanti, Tyler Tenney, and Katie Pope attended the Faculty Affairs committee meeting to discuss their committee's concerns and plan to attend the next Tenure and Academic Freedom committee meeting
 - iii. SGB has considered the policy and decided to endorse it. They are writing a letter of support that also includes some suggestions for improving its implementation
 - iv. Discussed having a joint meeting with reps from EIADAC, Faculty Affairs, Tenure and Academic Freedom, and SGB. Ally Bove will follow up with Tony Infanti to make sure this is OK, and we'll schedule the meeting, likely not until after the policy committee meets to discuss potential edits to the policy/procedure.
