1. Approval of Previous Minutes

2. Items of New Business

Viktoria Harms brought an issue about exit signage in the Cathedral of Learning. Deferred to the end of the meeting due to the tight timeline.

3. Committee Administrative Business

Committee was reminded that we are actively accepting / seeking topics for upcoming meetings.

4. Safety Update

 Ted Fritz, Vice Chancellor for Public Safety and Emergency Management

Ted updated the committee on crime alerts (in the context of a spate of alerts in late September / early October), as well as the emerging events related to the Israeli-Palestinian conflict.

 Molly Stitt-Fischer, PhD, Director of Environmental Health and Safety

Molly provided a review of the structure of Pitt's EH&S apparatus, including scope, mission, and some data patterns. Pertinent questions were fielded. It was noted that there is a deceptively large number of generators on campus.

5. Public Transportation Discussion

Matthew Sterne, Vice Chancellor for Business Services

Matthew reviewed some details of the University's interaction and negotiation process with Pittsburgh Regional Transit. Details of the planned BRT line were discussed. Mechanisms of Pitt community feedback for public transportation issues were reviewed. Future follow up with the committee was discussed as one such mechanism.
