	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• MS planning on reducing length to be “human readable”</li> <li>▪ Q: What does this accomplish? Spoof address and malicious intent protection</li> <li>▪ Q: What happens when a bad link is clicked? Catches most malicious activity via flagged content notification</li> <li>▪ Q: Are email links tracked?</li> <li>▪ Q: No longer using Safelinks? How are URLS extracted from archived emails ?</li> <li>▪ C: Police / Emergency Notification System emails now linked information- looks suspicious</li> <li>○ Safe Attachments - opens/scans attachments to detect malicious activity       <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ During Week of Oct. 8<sup>th</sup>- 290 known malicious attachments           <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Mostly MS or PDF extensions</li> </ul> </li> </ul> </li> <li>○ Q: Zip files as an attachment ? ZIP files are not read beyond the manifest</li> <li>○ Q: Internal to internal mail now examined?</li> <li>○ Q: Is there a holding area for non-malicious messages such as spam-quarantined area?</li> <li>○ Q:Course Web implantation? Attachments are scanned.</li> </ul>
